East Brady residents can now pay their water/sewer bill on line! We now have a secure link on our web-site where you can use your credit/debit card to pay your water/sewer bill online. A 3% service fee is added for this convenience. Reminder.....Bills are **due the last day of the month**. They must be received in the office by that day. If you think the post office will not deliver it by the last day, use the bill drop box located at the Ferry St. corner of the Community Center. The next day a late fee is assessed. Save yourself a little money and pay your bill on time. If you have water line insurance added to your bill, and the bill is **NOT** paid on time, your line insurance is not in effect.

Ordinance info

Ordinance 2019-01 is our Nuisance Ordinance. Section 2 deals with property maintenance. Section A (iv) states: Grass, leaves and snow removal—No person shall mow grass, rake leaves, shovel snow, blow snow or plow snow out onto any Borough Street or alley.

This debris clogs our storm sewer drains. Grass clippings can be very dangerous to motorcycles. We are just trying to keep everyone safe and maintain the Borough infrastructure.
