East Brady residents can now pay their water/sewer bill on line! We now have a secure link on our web-site where you can use your credit/debit card to pay your water/sewer bill on line. A 3% service fee is added for this convenience.

We have added an **OUTSIDE** bill drop box for water/sewer payments. It is located at the Ferry Street entrance to the Community Center at the corner of Ferry and Robinson St. You can place your payments in it at any time. The box is emptied every day.

Our Council meetings are at 6 pm on the first Tuesday of EVERY month. We usually have a second meeting on the 3rd Tuesday also.

If you have any questions or concerns you would like to address, please attend a meeting. Everyone is welcome to attend, or you can just come and listen. Please refrain from interrupting our councilmen at their place of business. They volunteer to be on council, but they still work to provide for their families. You can always come to the Borough office, a council meeting, call or email your questions or concerns.

East Brady Water/Sewer

Our Sewer Committee in coordination with our Engineer have adjusted the sewage rate. Residential customers will now be paying \$87.00 base rate per quarter. The cost for each thousand gallons of sewage is \$5.00. The sewage improvement fund charge of \$9.00 remains the same. This increase will take effect in the LAST quarter of 2020. You will see the adjusted rate in the bill you receive the beginning of January 2021. The increase is necessary due to increased costs for chemicals and machinery. We certainly don't like doing this, but we find no other choice.
