East Brady residents can now pay their water/sewer bill on line! We now have a secure link on our web-site where you can use your credit/debit card to pay your water/sewer bill online. A 3% service fee is added for this convenience.

We have added an **OUTSIDE** bill drop box for water/sewer payments. It is located at the Ferry Street entrance to the Community Center at the corner of Ferry and Robinson St. You can place your payments in it at any time. The box is emptied every day.

In an effort to stop the spread of COVID-19, please use the drop box or mail your bill. Allow extra time with the mail. It seems to be slower than usual. If you need to come into the office to pay a bill in cash, please wear a mask.

You have noticed that the charge for sewage has been increased. The notice was included with your last bill.

WATER METER LOCATIONS

Please try to keep the area around your water meter accessible. In an emergency we may need to get to your meter and the area near it should be easy to get to. If not, we would have to shut the water off at the curb stop. Thank you for cooperating.

CONTACT INFORMATION

In October we had to turn the water off to replace a valve in the system. The night before, we sent a "Public Alert" message to warn everyone. If you did not get the alert, it is because we do not have accurate information for you. We can send alerts by text message, by email or with a voice message. If you have your phone programmed so that it does not receive telemarketer calls, then you will not receive the call. Landlords, please let us know who lives in your rentals, or pass the info on to them.

Landlord Tenant Information

Landlords, please remember that the upkeep of your property is your responsibility. Snow must be removed from sidewalks within 12 hours of a snowstorm or a citation will be issued to the OWNER. The same goes with grass cutting in the spring/summer. It is up to you to coordinate clean up with your tenants. If the property is vacant, it still needs to be maintained.

East Brady Borough **does not** provide municipal trash removal. You must contract individually with either Schumachers Refuse or Advanced Disposal (formerly Downing Sanitation). Once again, if trash is not disposed of properly, the property OWNER will be issued a citation.
